Outdoor Recreational Facilities Use

Measures shall be taken by the school administration to secure school property against trespass.

The Board wishes the public to make use of the school system's outdoor recreational facilities when these facilities are available for public use. The facilities will be used in accordance with the Board's Community Use of School Facilities and Equipment (11.03) policy and procedures when applicable. The Superintendent/designee will develop guidelines for other use of facilities not covered under policy 11.03.

School personnel have the Board's authority to ask any person who is inappropriately using the school's outdoor recreational facilities to leave, and to inform the police should the person(s) fail to do so.

All Terrain Vehicles (ATV)/Snowmobiles are prohibited from operating on school property while school is in session or during school activities. Violators will be reported to the police.

School approved events may provide a special exemption to this policy.

ATV Definitions:

ATV means a motor driven, off road, recreational vehicle capable of cross country travel on land, snow, ice, marsh, swampland or other natural terrain. It includes, but is not limited to, a multi-track, a multi-wheel or low pressure tire vehicle; a motorcycle or related 2-wheel, 3-wheel or 4-wheel vehicle. Trail bikes and dirt bikes are also included in this policy.
