

**MAINE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT #53  
Burnham – Detroit - Pittsfield**

**Policy: Tutoring**

Maine School Administrative District #53 will provide temporary tutorial services to students unable to physically attend regular class sessions in the schools of the District. Tutorial services may be provided when the following criteria are evident:

Medical evidence that a student is unable to attend regular classes for a short term ( up to 10 days). The school administrator will determine need.

Absence, due to medical reasons, that would last beyond ten days. The school will initiate a referral to the Student Assistance Team to determine accommodations and need.

A student with disabilities shall be provided instruction as ordered on that student's Individualized Educational Program.
